Hello and welcome to the final round of the British Supermoto & Superlite Championship.

Cadwell is our traditional final venue and although not by any means a typical Supermoto track we always get amazingly close racing and with double points up for grabs we are sure to see most championships go down to the last lap of the last race of the day.

The majority of the bikes you will see out on track will be based on 450cc MX bikes from Honda, Husaberg Husqvarna KTM and Yamaha but check out the guys in the EVO class. These are bikes generally built before 2008 and run carburettors not fuel injection. You will also hear the sound of the two stroke bikes battling for our two stroke prize. All the bikes will run slick tyres if the conditions are dry and with uprated suspension and brakes the lap times will surprise many of you.

In our 4 wheel Superlite class, three different engines are used, although all the cars battle it out on track together in A & B races their overall positions are based on class. S6 are 650cc 2-stroke Rotax engines, S9 are the old generation 900cc Honda Fireblade motors and our newest class the incredibly quick S10 CBR1000 engined cars. If track conditions are tricky look for the less powerful cars getting further up the field.

One thing we can promise you is some hot action on the track and whether on 2 wheels or 4 we are sure you will enjoy the experience of seeing our stars do their thing in a unnatural environment for Supermoto.


A big shout out to all the Marshalls, Medics, Timekeepers, Photographers and Circuit Staff without whom we wouldn't be able to race.

Circuit warning signals

- GREEN**: All clear at the end of danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap. No overtaking.
- YELLOW**: Danger also clear sufficiently to ensure full control of the vehicle can be retained.
- BLUE**: This flag encourages competitor to move aside to allow faster traffic to pass.
- RED**: The race or practice session is stopped. Riders must return slowly to the pits or as directed by the marshals.
- YELLOW & BLACK CROSS**: Shows the the chequered flag is to be used in the next lap.
- CHEQUERED**: End of race or practice session.
