### **WELCOME**





elcome to Brands Hatch for today's MSVR Club Car Championships meeting.

July marked the long-awaited restart of motorsport activity in 2020 in the wake of the global COVID-19 crisis. In line with both

government and Motorsport UK guidelines, both MSV and MSVR put in place a raft of measures to minimise the risk of resuming our sporting activities, and these are being constantly reviewed as the situation evolves. More information and advice can be found later in this digital event programme and you will also find new signage and facilities around the site. Your cooperation in adhering to these new policies is appreciated – and, indeed, vital – if we are to continue running events for the sport we all love.

The action gets underway with the Track Attack Race Club, who join the MSVR fold this year, bringing their collection of globally-inspired classes – Nippon Challenge for Japanese and Korean cars, Tricolore Trophy for French cars and Deutsche Marques for German models.

The Project 8 Racing Club brings both of its categories together on one grid this weekend, as the Toyo Tires Racing Saloons combine with the Production BMW Championship. Racing Saloons is home to everything from powerful BMW E36 M3s to Jaguar XKs and XJSs, and they are joined by the Classic VW Cup this season (for pre-2003 VAG group cars). Production BMW meanwhile is home to the E30 generation BMW 3 series, offering budget friendly, rear wheel drive excitement in the true vein of club motorsport. Also joining this bumper grid are the Z Cars Series, which stars BMW's Z3 and Z4 roadsters.

The Quaife MINI CHALLENGE Trophy arrives to tackle the tight Indy circuit today, with the iconic MINI racers being perfectly suited. Expect some fierce battles throughout the field!

Another British icon, Norfolk's finest arrive in Kent with the MSVR Elise Trophy Championship. Lotus' lightweight, mid-engine, rear wheel drive setup is also well matched to the tight and technical Indy circuit and they always produce exciting racing.

The Champion of Brands caters for the iconic 1600cc Formula Ford racers – for many years these cars were the proving ground for F1 stars of the future and the racing is no less exciting nowadays.

Completing today's line-up, and organised by our sister department MSV Trackdays (MSVT), the SuperCup championship is the top of their racing ladder. Running their familiar format of a 45 minute pit stop race, the more powerful Class S and Class A cars produce some seriously quick lap times.

Motorsport in the UK simply couldn't happen without the invaluable work of the many volunteer marshals up and down the country. The "orange army" give up their time to ensure we can put on these events and they keep the drivers safe. I would like to offer the first thanks of many to all the marshals and volunteer officials for their help this weekend. As a thank you, one lucky marshal will win a PalmerSport Formula 3000 drive at MSV's Bedford Autodrome.

### **COMPETITOR ADVICE**

As the motorsport world restarts this summer, MSVR is putting in place a number of changes to ensure we can resume our race events safely and enjoyably, while complying with Motorsport UK and government guidelines.

Please read this advice carefully as most administrative aspects of a race meeting have changed in some way.

### **SIGNING ON**

- All signing on for the event will now take place online, ahead of the event
- The link will be available under the event information on the calendar page of the MSVR website
- The signing-on process includes your scrutineering declaration and part of your briefing (see below)

### **SCRUTINEERING**

- As part of the signing-on process you will submit your car and safety equipment information, self declaring your compliance with Motorsport UK regulations
- This information will be passed to the Chief Scrutineer ahead of the weekend, and the scrutineers of the meeting will have the power to perform spot checks throughout the event, to ensure compliance with all relevant regulations
- Please remember that the standard Motorsport UK penalties continue to apply for non-compliance

### **COMPETITOR BRIEFINGS**

- As part of the signing-on process you will go through a preliminary safety briefing. You MUST go through this from start to finish to complete the signing-on process
- You may receive additional briefing notes via your coordinator or the Clerk of the Course. Please ensure you are also familiar with these before your first session on circuit

### **RACE ADMINISTRATION**

- No printed results or bulletins will be available to collect.
   The event page on the MSVR website will become a "virtual noticeboard" and should become your first port of call for event documentation
- Transponder hire will still be available but should be booked in advance with TSL – www.tsl-timing.com or 01827 285666

### JUDICIAL GUIDANCE

- As a result of distancing measures, the usual judicial procedures are changing
- Detailed information is available from the Motorsport UK website – please ensure you are familiar with the new guidelines at <u>www.motorsportuk.org/restart</u>

### **VENUE RESTRICTIONS**

- Pass numbers will initially be limited to assist with social distancing requirements and are for competitors and their essential helpers only
- The paddock(s) will be closed to non-essential personnel at all MSVR events until further notice
- Garage doors should remain open front and back when the garage is occupied
- Unfortunately there will be no podium ceremonies at MSVR events in September. This will be regularly reviewed
- Other restrictions may apply at individual venues and must be complied with
- Competitors will be required to wear face coverings when inside venue buildings. Signage will be in place to support this
- Access to Race Control is restricted to essential personnel only

### ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR TEAMS

- Teams must consider bringing the minimum number of people required to an event
- Teams are recommended to bring their own first aid kit, etc. to minimise the need to use the circuit medical resources
- Teams should bring adequate PPE for all personnel and retain a record of those attending the event

### **OTHER CONSIDERATIONS**

- DO NOT visit the medical centre if you suspect you have COVID-19 symptoms. If you begin to feel unwell during the event, notify the organisers and leave the venue in line with government guidance.
- Restaurants/toilets/shower facilities will vary by venue for the latest updates please check the circuit website
- Overnight stays are permitted from Thursday (for Friday testing only) and Friday (for the race weekend) – again please check the circuit website for details
- Be advised that circuit management retain the right to pause or stop track activities if health and safety protocols (COVID-19 related or otherwise) are consistently breached
- Be mindful of the requirements of any local lockdown that may restrict your ability to travel or stay overnight outside of your home, and contact us if you believe this restriction may apply to you

**IMPORTANT:** You <u>must not</u> attend any race meeting if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, or you are required to self-isolate under Government guidelines

### **CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION**

### **FLAGS**

### **BLUE (STEADY)**

Another competitor is close.

### **BLUE (WAVED)**

Another competitor is trying to pass.

### WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

### YELLOW (WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

### YELLOW (DOUBLE WAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking. (This signal may be supplemented or replaced by flashing yellow light(s), as an added warning).

### YELLOW/RED STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.

### **GREEN (WAVED)**

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and shown at all posts during first lap of each practice session and during the formation lap.

### RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals (at startline & individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.

### **BLACK/ORANGE DISK**

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

### **BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL**

Warning to driver that his/her behaviour (e.g. corner cutting) is suspect and he/her may be black flagged.

### **BLACK**

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

### **BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED** End of the race.

### **CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION**

Motor Racing is dangerous and persons attending the meeting do so entirely at their own risk.
